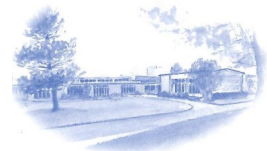

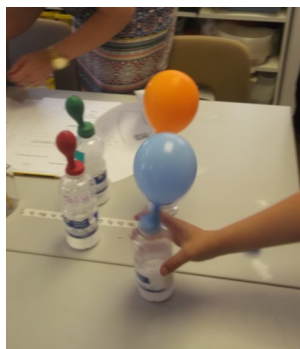
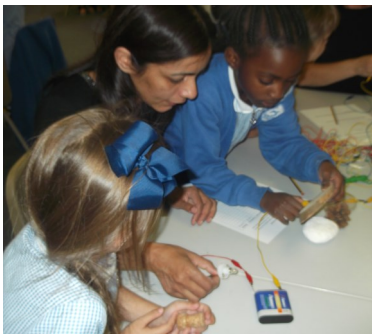
Congratulations to the Year 1 children who visited Wildwood and represented our school brilliantly.
