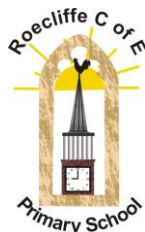

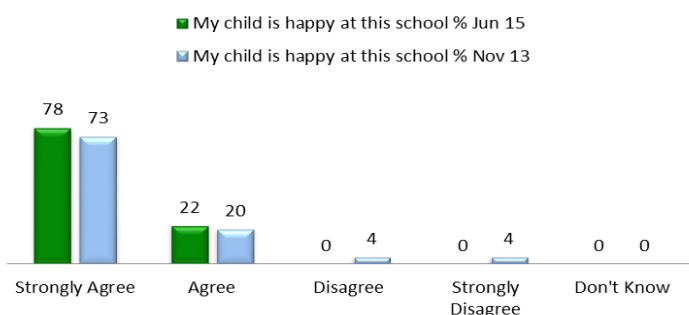

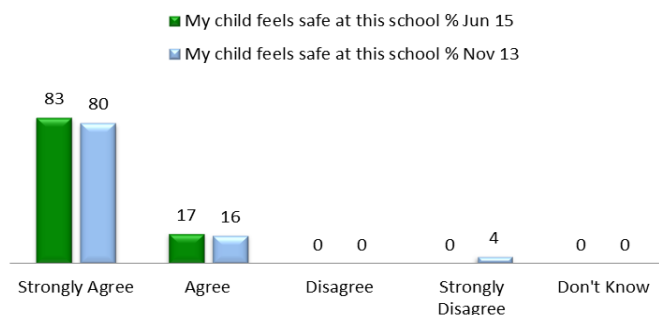
### My child is happy at this school

- Maintain the 100% positive response through the school's strong Christian ethos and school values.

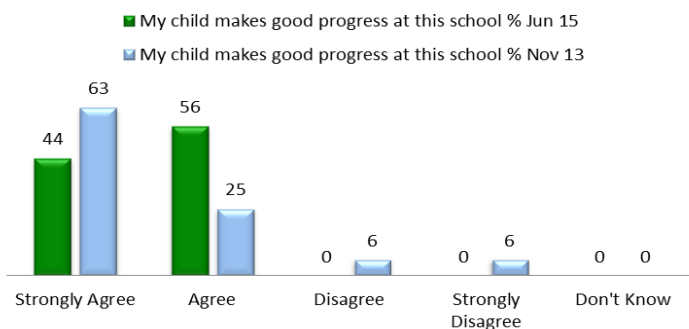
### My child feels safe at this school

- Maintain the 100% positive response through the school's rigorous safeguarding procedures.

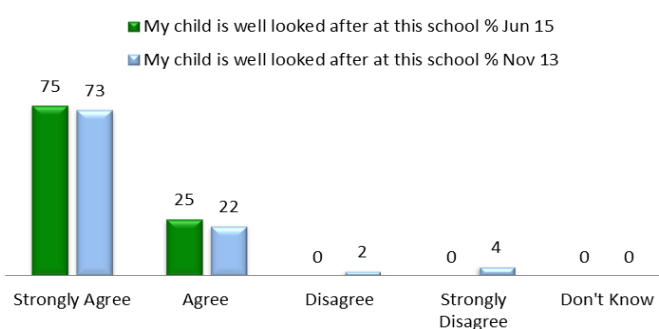
### My child makes good progress at this school

- Ensure parents' evenings and reports make clear the progress that has been made from previous year/term.

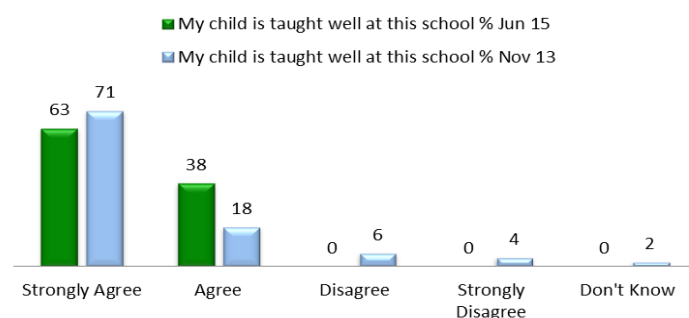
### My child is well looked after at this school

- Maintain the 100% positive response through pastoral care and personal, social and emotional curriculum.

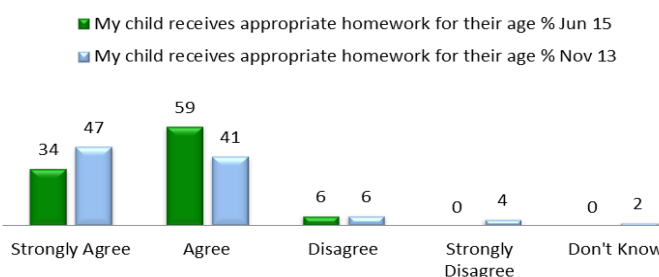
### My child is taught well at this school

- Continued focus on raising standards in reading, writing and mathematics, through an enriching curriculum.

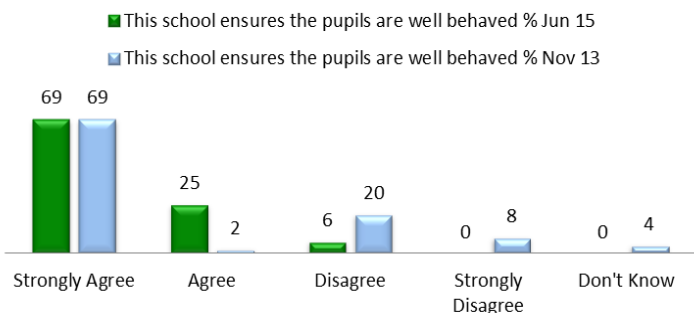
### My child receives appropriate homework for their age

- Revised homework policy for September 2015 with more consistency in homework throughout Years 1-6.

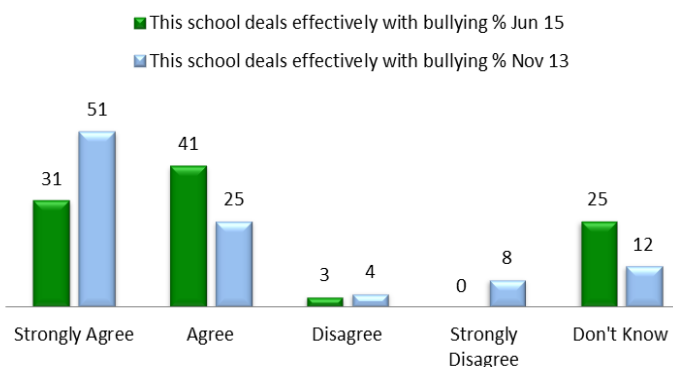
### This school ensures the pupils are well behaved

- Review of how we record pupils' behaviour over time, for example incident logs and rewards and sanctions

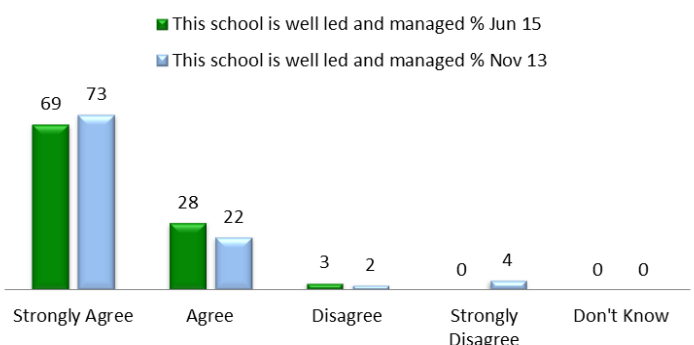
### This school deals effectively with bullying

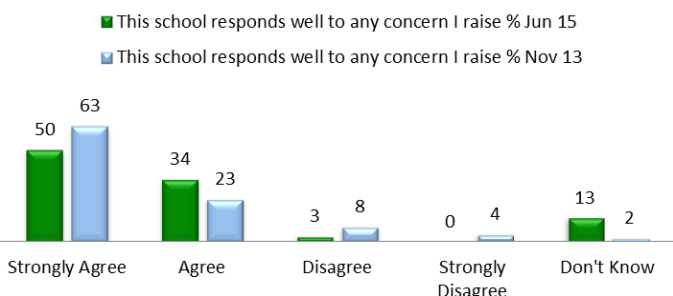
### This school is well led and managed

- Annual Parent View survey to be conducted each Summer Term to receive parents' feedback on the school.

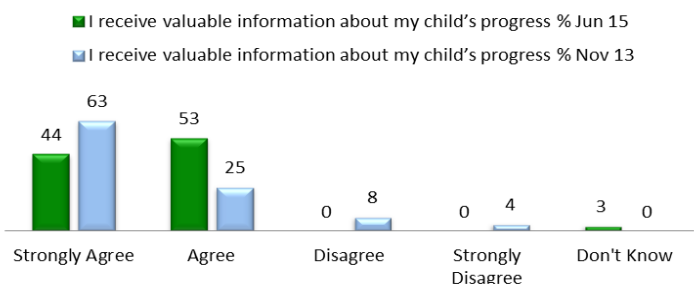
### This school responds well to any concern I raise

- All concerns raised to be reviewed by headteacher.

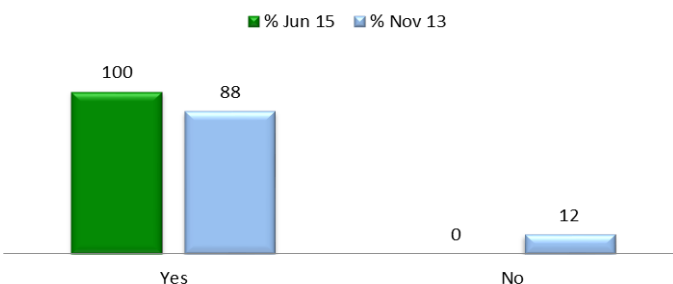
### I receive valuable information about my child's progress
