<b>FUNTIME</b> To develop speaking skills, self-confidence and positive attitudes to learning. Small group work: 4-6 children and 1 adult. 20 minutes once per week. Led by a trained assistant.							
<b>DOUGH DISCO</b> To develop fine motor skills and concentration. Small group work: 4-6 children and 1 adult. 20 minutes three times per week. Led by a trained assistant.							
<b>BRWP</b> To consolidate early Reading and Writing skills. One child to one adult. Led by a trained assistant. 30 minutes daily. Ongoing support is reviewed termly.							
<b>RUTH MISKIN LITERACY</b> To consolidate early Reading and Writing skills. One child to one adult or small groups of 2-4 children. Led by a trained assistant. 30 minutes daily. Ongoing support is reviewed termly.							
<b>1<sup>st</sup> CLASS@NUMBER</b> To consolidate early mathematics skills. Small group work: 4-6 children and 1 adult. 20 minutes three times per week. 10 week programme. Led by a trained assistant.							
<b>LANGUAGE SUPPORT</b> Small group of 3-6 pupils. Twice a week. 45 minutes each session. Led by a trained assistant.							
<b>ENGLISH BOOSTER</b> To develop key English skills. Small groups of 4-8 children and 1 adult. Twice weekly support reviewed termly. Led by a trained teacher.							
<b>MATHEMATICS BOOSTER</b> To develop key Mathematics skills. Small groups of 4-8 children and 1 adult. Twice weekly support reviewed termly. Led by a trained teacher.							
<b>SUCCESS@ARITHMETIC</b> To consolidate mathematics skills at Key Stage 2. Small group work: 4-6 children and 1 adult. 20 minutes three times per week. 10 week programme. Led by a trained assistant.							
<b>INFERENCE TRAINING</b> To develop higher order reading skills. Small group work. 4-8 children and 1 adult. 10 week programme. Led by a trained teacher or assistant.							
<b>SPEED-UP</b> A handwriting intervention for Key Stage 2 pupils. Small group work: 4-6 pupils and 1 adult. 3-4 sessions per week Led by a trained teacher or assistant.							

**1:1 TUTORING**

Bespoke support linked to an individual child's targets.  
1 child to 1 adult. 2-3 times per week.  
Led by a trained assistant.
