

Teaching of phonics-

Feedback from our recent reading meeting suggested that many parents wanted more knowledge of how we teach phonics in school. Here is a helpful guide to show what children learn in phonics.

Phonics is taught daily in school for 20 minutes. Phonics is split into phases, starting with phase 1 and continuing to phase 6. Children start in phase 1 in Nursery.

This handout has been designed to help you see a simple overview of what your child is learning in phonics at the moment.

Phase 2

Here is a list of sounds that children learn in phase 2:
