Remit
<p>Our school receives extra school sports funding from the Government. We intend to use the money we get to provide high quality games coaching for KS2. We aim to increase the competitive opportunities for children via cluster wide inter-school and Calderdale wide competitions. We aim to provide subsidised after school clubs which introduce our children to new sports experiences. We aim to improve our resources so that students get to use the best quality apparatus in games and gymnastics.</p>
Proposed expenditure

This funding will secure Calder Valley Collaborative cluster (HX7 Sports) partnership.• £2,340 for quality games coaching for KS2• £1170 to cover after school sessions with a specialist coach• £1286 to cover costs of swimming sessions for 1 year• £1200 to support Forest School participation across two key year groups• £500 to cover CPD for current staff• £200 for medals and prizes• £1000 for new equipment for gymnastics and for small games skills
Expected impact of expenditure
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Quality of teaching at least good (80%) with percentage of outstanding provision (20%)• Increased teacher confidence with planning and delivery of PE• After school clubs with unusual sports well attended – all places taken• Increased pupil participation in competitions• Increase in range of inter school competitions school takes part in• Pupil enjoyment of PE lessons and sport increases from a baseline taken in autumn term.
