

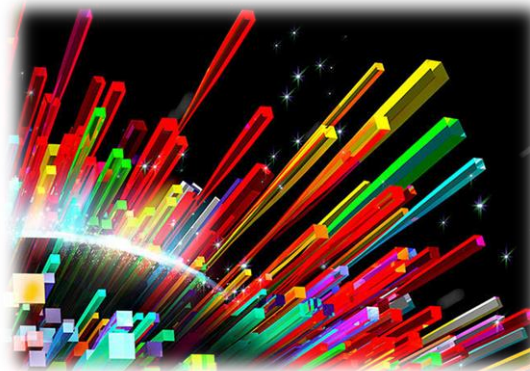
CREATIVE CURRICULUM

SKILLS CHECKLIST

Geography

- Experience, explore and investigate a variety of people, places and environments near the school and another contrasting area.
- Investigate how people affect and how they may be effected by the environment- caring for it and affecting the future
- Notice and comment on contrasts, similarities and differences in the school and local area

Year Group: KS2 Yr 5 and 6 Term: Autumn



History

(History topics are covered over a two year cycle)

- Experience everyday artefacts, cultures and traditions from other countries
- Understand how exploration of the world led to change
- Identify the contribution of an individual to our history through research, role play and a variety of historical sources.
- Use dates that link to period and time

Art and Design

- Research art from another culture, exploring colour and pattern
- Develop their own practical and creative skills and improve control of materials and tools.
- Design and construct for a given purpose (i.e. a shelter)
- Produce their own work inspired by artists and craftspeople – display

Design Technology

- Design and construct a model for a specific purpose
- To make choices by looking at and identifying features and elements of designs.
- Evaluate their work, providing reasons for their views, identifying what works well or what needs changing.
- Think about what products are used for and the needs of the people who use them.
