SKILLS CHECKLIST

Geography

- Identify locations using maps, atlases and globes, ask geographical questions.
- Make comparisons between town and country looking at similarities and differences and provide reasons for this.
- Study the movement and migration of specific groups of people and the causes and consequences of this.

Year Group: KS3 Yr 7, 8 and 9 Term: Autumn



History

(History topics covered over a three year cycle)

- Identify reasons why there is war and specific features of warfare
- Show empathy with people who lived in the past . Talk about their own family, the past and the present, events in their own life.
- Use a range of historical sources, interpretations and artefacts to answer enquiry questions about the past.
- Communicate their own feelings and ideas about the past in a variety of ways.

Art and Design

- Identify the themes of paintings and identify the colours, shapes and textures used.
- Experiment with colour to create depth and light
- Look at the work of wartime artists, propaganda and discuss the motivations of work of particular interest.
- Try to paint in the style of the artist.
- Use a variety of materials and processes to record observations, ideas and feelings and to make images and artefacts

Design Technology

- Explore and investigate a range of different fabrics and sort to given criteria.
- Experience and develop skills of decorating techniques
- Make choices about a product or aspects of its design and communicate design proposals in a variety of ways. Communicate variations in design proposals.
- Use learned techniques to decide next steps and produce final product.
- Judge the quality of their own and others' products.
