Art and Design

- Experiment with, and combine colour, texture, shape, form and space in 2 and 3 dimensions
- Experiment with and choose from different materials and suitable tools to make images and artefacts, extending and refining their skills.
- Investigating and making materials and techniques.
- Respond in different ways to their own work and show likes and dislikes about the work of others

Design Technology

- Observe, explore and experience a range of materials and tools
- Communicate design proposals in a variety of ways
- Develop their ideas by taking into account how their product will be used and who will use them
- Judge the quality of other people's products.
- Make hot and cold snacks and meals. Identify ingredients and tools needed.
- Develop, plan and communicate ideas. Evaluate process and final product. Make models linked to the theme.

History

(History topics covered over a three year cycle)

- Experience aspects of the lives of others in different places and periods in the past
- Experience a range of historical sources and interpretations and communicate their views
- Sequence events in chronological order and place some events and people in correct time periods.
- Use appropriate dates that link to the period, place, events and people and changes into the correct time period.
