PE and Sports Funding

Bisley C of E (VA) Primary School understands and values the importance of physical activity and sport. The children are encouraged to undertake a range of sports and activities both within the Physical Education (PE) curriculum and also in extra curricular activities. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport have allocated ring fenced funding to support the provision of PE and sport in schools.

During the academic year 2014/2015, we have decided to spend this money in the following way:

- Affiliations to leagues and competitions for a range of sports
- Professional Development of staff to ensure high quality PE curriculum teaching
- Opportunities for year groups to experience inter-school competitions
- Providing extra-curricular activities in a broader range of sports, encouraging all children to be involved. Clubs such as Judo, Basket Ball and Multi – Skills are proving popular.
- Maintaining and extending gym equipment in order that children have opportunities to develop skills in gymnastics
- Purchasing further playground (and wet play resources) to encourage children to be active at playtimes.
- Purchasing further teaching resources and guidance to enable teachers to provide high quality PE lessons
- Provision of opportunities for children in Year 5 to swim 25M with confidence

Impact

We have continued to take part in a range of local football, netball and cross country competitions this year and have achieved some success. The children have also had the opportunity to take part in a Swimming Gala and a range of county –wide events.

72%% of keystone 2 children take part in a sporting club provided by the school staff and external teachers/coaches.

Provision for externally run clubs has been extended and now includes a Judo club as well as football, and basketball.

All teaching staff have received professional development in PE and sport which has had direct impact on the quality of their teaching.

In order to give all children further opportunities to be active and develop skills in PE, we have extended the range of equipment available at playtimes.

As a school, Bisley C of E Primary is proud of the opportunities that are provided through extra-curricular and competitive sport for the children. In the past twelve months the following range of sporting clubs have been on offer to children within the school: Athletics, Cricket, Football, Judo, Multi-Skills, Basket Ball, Netball,
