Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2011/12

Using staff knowledge and Attainment data, groups of pupils are provided with targeted teaching and support, regularly being reviewed. The above mentioned interventions are embedded across the school, with future planning to adapt these following suitable evaluations of outcomes.

Pupil progress meetings are held to discuss individual cases.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The school will evaluate the impact on each pupil at the end of each term. Evaluation will focus on academic gains and how pupils' self-confidence has developed as a consequence of the intervention.

Success criteria would demonstrate good progress from data progress reports. Those pupils entitled to Pupil Premium have attainment progress tracked to monitor and evaluate the impact of interventions. This is in addition to their individual and class progress tracking. In this way the school can determine the value of its interventions and can ensure that the Pupil Premium funding is distributed to maximum effect.
