

Pupil Premium 2013-2014

The Pupil Premium is allocated to children from low-income families who are currently known to be eligible for FSM in both mainstream and non-mainstream settings and children who have been looked after continuously for more than six months.

Fund available - £18,900

How we spent the money in 2013-2014

Teacher costs and Every Child Counts - £13,505.91

The result of this spending is:-

Key Stage 2 SATs progress from KS1

Writing: 5/8 children 2 levels progress, 3/8 children 3 levels progress

Maths: 8/10 children 2 levels progress, 2/10 children 3 levels progress

Year 5 maths average progress (after 10 weeks course) 1/3 level

Year 5 reading average progress (after 10 weeks course) 1/2 level

Year 4 reading average progress (after 10 weeks course) 1/2 level

Year 2 Every Child Counts progress 9 children 0.8 levels on average

LSA costs - £5,893.93

Librarian, plus 1:1 reading support for 3 children - 18 months reading age improvement on average
