## Curriculum

### The School Will:

promote high academic standards;

maintain a high quality environment with good materials and equipment.

### I Will:

take an interest in what my child is learning;

praise my child for good work.

## Behaviour

### The School Will:

promote high standards of behaviour;  
make sure staff, children and parents know what behaviour is expected;  
use rewards and sanctions fairly;  
let parents know of any concerns regarding behaviour.

### I Will:

give praise for good behaviour ;  
support the school's policies and guidelines for promoting good behaviour;  
behave in a way that sets a good example to children when I am on the school premises.

## Equal Opportunities
