

## School development plan 2015-2016

We have had another successful year:

- Outstanding assessment results in EYFS - GLDs increased from 82% to 83% .National in 2014 was 60% there is no 2015 data yet
- Year 1 phonic screen results were above the National standards, of 77% with 79% meeting the standard. From the Year 2 re-screens there was an increase from 82% to 87% meeting the standard.
- Key stage 1 results are good with the core subjects average point score being 16.6 (above LA 15.5 and National 15.9 figures of 2014) This equates to 76.1% of children achieving level 2B or above in the core subjects.
- The percentage of children achieving a L3 or above in core subjects increased from 14.2% in 2013 to 16.5%
- Our emerging leaders have completed a set programme over this year, regularly meeting with their mentors.
- The key stage 1 outdoor classroom was updated, with phase 1 being completed.
- The ICT infrastructure was upgraded
- LA moderation of Key Stage 1 assessments

Challenges to 2015 include:

- Training for and managing specific medical / developmental needs of individual children
- Workforce Remodelling
- Increased case loads for safeguarding including LAC and special guardianships
- Removal of levels and new Y2 testing—national benchmarks
