Those things that the school needs to improve, find a solution to it by approaching the problem differently.</p> <p>Nursery location – parents feel cut off.</p>	<p>Facebook page (closed) – no comment allowed/admin sensored comments only.</p> <p>Dad involvement – day days/activities (weekends/half term , camping).</p> <p>Bringing dads to school.</p> <p>Introduce music at an early age.</p> <p>Consider an after school club (homework club) run by parents or volunteers. This will be useful for working parents and to develop children’s social skills.</p> <p>Zooming in on talents – developing the child’s own skills.</p> <p>Introduction of life skills at an early age.</p> <p>Parents come in early 8.30am to read to children.</p>
