Differentiation and Personalisation of Curriculum. SENCo available for advice but led by Teacher/Lead Provider Educational Professional



If there are still difficulties after the above have been completed and evidenced, a SENCo intervention form needs to be completed



SENCo will then undertake solution circles and/or observations to aid further personalisation/differentiation in the classroom. After initial outcomes given, there will be two reviews (every three weeks) to ascertain success and or review next steps including short term specific intensive interventions. In exceptional cases outside agencies will be involved.



If school based personalisation/interventions/differentiation fails to narrow the gap, a professional meeting will be called to look at further agency involvement. A parent meeting will be called to discuss further interventions and if not already in place, a CAF will be initiated. (Note if there is already higher outside agency involvement, then normal processes will be followed)



When all the above have been evidenced and there are still difficulties in place (whether interventions have taken place in mainstream or after exclusion), a school based EHCP application may be considered. (Please note parents can apply for the process to begin at any time during this procedure.)
