Name the WPS Bus Competition Results

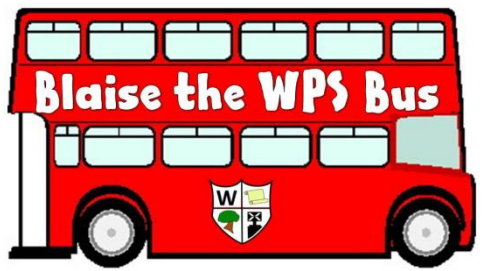
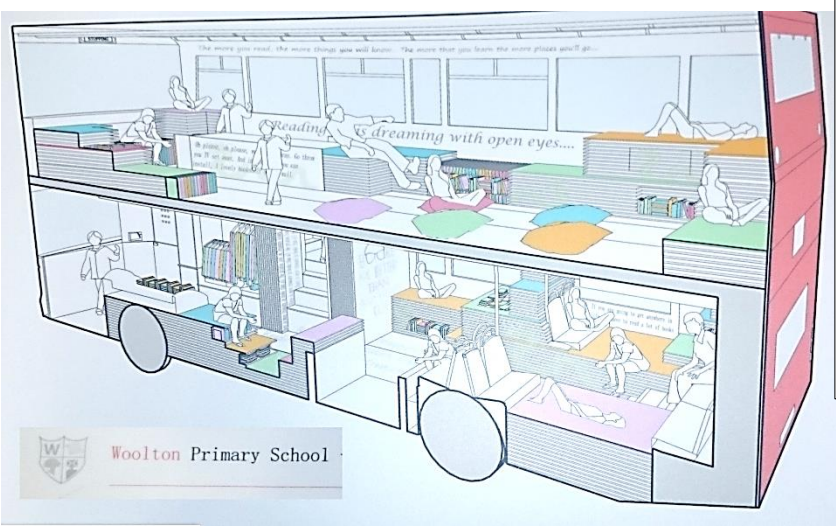
