

Key Stage 2 Results from 2012

Please note that cohort size can have a significant impact on this data.

A cohort of 20 - one child = 5%

A cohort of 12 - one child = 8.5%

The table below shows progress from Key Stage One to Two, average progress is 2 levels.

The table below shows attainment in Key Stage Two, the expected standard is level 4.

The table below shows average points score for pupils at the end of year 6

Average Points Score mathematics	30.7	28.9	31.6	28.2
Combined (R, W & M)	29.5	29.1	29.3	28.1

The table below shows higher attainment from pupils in Key Stage Two, these children have achieved level 5 or greater.
