Do something kind for a family member (make someone their breakfast, tidy their bedroom, help out with chores)	Explore reversible (melting chocolate) and irreversible changes (making toast) when cooking with family	Identify where their food has come from by reading the labels and finding the country on google Earth
MILD 	Practice writing cvc words (cat, dog, hat etc) and initial blend words (plum, crab etc) on paper or in sensory materials e.g icing sugar	Explore a range of coins and make different values up to 10, or add amounts up to 10p	Get dressed for school independently	Make their own breakfast	Identify something that has happened in the news over the weekend. Can watch Newsround to help.
