Dear Parent / Guardian

In the Summer term Year 6 will be invited to take part in an exciting Forest School programme at Panshanger Park. We will visit local woodland for a half-day session once a week for 5 weeks after the May half term in 2016.

Forest Schools are designed to inspire children through a long term, educational approach to outdoor play and learning in the natural environment. The programme will support the national curriculum whilst also enabling your child to build confidence and develop their social and creative skills. The Forest School is run by trained Forest School Leaders from Herts and Middlesex Wildlife Trust, who are working in partnership with Lafarge Tarmac to deliver an exciting new Forest School initiative based at Panshanger Park. There will need to be a cost for these sessions @£30 per child. The cost covers the sessions with the Forest Leader at Panshanger Park, the minibus costs to transport the children to the park and use of their waterproofs whilst we are there.

As a result of this, we thought we would give you as much notice as possible. The sessions are not compulsory, but we are hoping that all the Year 6 children will be able to come along.
