- Referral to appropriate professionals if necessary and according to the needs of the child

Aston C of E asks parents to support the work of the school, its aims and Christian Ethos and the children's learning by:-

- Keeping unauthorised absences to a minimum and informing school as soon as possible of the reason for a child's absence
- Ensuring that their child realises the importance of education, good manners and how to behave appropriately

- Work with the teaching staff to overcome any difficulties which their children may experience at school

- Informing us of any medical or home problems which might affect the child
- Encouraging their child to take a full and active part in school life
