

Stained Glass Windows

Over the past few weeks we have planned, made and evaluated our own stained glass windows inspired by our School Christian Values.

First we got into pairs and decided on what value we would do. The School Christian Values are:

- Friendship
- Justice e.g. Jonah and the Whale
- Thankfulness e.g. The Wise Men Visit
- Service e.g. Jesus' Birth
- Compassion e.g. Jesus and the Children
- Generosity e.g. Moses' Mothers
- Forgiveness e.g. The Tax Collector
- Courage e.g. Noah's Ark
- Truthfulness e.g. Judas
- Respect e.g. The Plagues
- Creativity e.g. Joseph and his Dream Coat, The Creation
- Perseverance e.g. The Lost Coin

After we had found our Bible story and reference we got a 6 circle template. Then we sketched our initial ideas onto the circles.

Once we had chosen our final design and were contented with it. We sketched it onto a full sized circle template. We used acrylic paints to paint our final piece onto a plastic disc, which looked like a stained glass window.
