

Sports School Funding

The Sports Premium is an amount of funding provided to schools by central Government. The funding must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport to encourage pupils to develop healthy lifestyles.

Our 2015-16 allocation is £6000 (£9000 if continued to next financial year TBC and then allocated)
