

## **Boughton Leigh Junior School HOMEWORK POLICY**

### **Rationale**

- Boughton Leigh Junior School believes that homework plays an important role in learning and should be set regularly for all pupils.
- We set homework as an opportunity for pupils to develop skills of independent learning and therefore homework should be formally recorded by pupils and monitored, assessed and checked by staff.
- Homework should provide an opportunity for differentiation and should be an encouragement to individual pupils to consolidate basic skills and develop research skills through their project work.

### **Implementation**

- It is the responsibility of each classteacher to provide homework in line with the rest of their year group.
- It should be the responsibility of the classteacher to inform parents if homework is not completed or handed in at the appropriate time.
- Within each class clear standards need to be established about the quality of work which is expected to be produced during homework time.
- Not all homework needs to be a written task, but whatever the task it should be clearly defined for students.
