

Reception: Term 3

This term, our topic is 'Real Life Superheroes'. We will be finding out about different occupations, particularly people who help us. We will introduce a different occupation each week to include chefs, police officers, vets and doctors.



Literacy

In phonics sessions, we will be re-capping on the 44 initial graphemes and beginning to read words that contain digraphs (e.g. 'ai' and 'oa'). We will be focusing on writing lists and labels through our topic work.

Mathematics

This term we will continue to work on recognising and writing numerals to 10 and beyond. We will also be focusing on measures, including time (days of the week) and money. This will tie in with the use of the vets role play area in the classroom, where children will be able to make appointments (days of the week), measure animals (weight and length) and pay vets bills (money).

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

As part of our 'real-life superheroes' topic, we will be finding out about adult and baby animals (linked to vets), staying safe in the home (fire officers), knowing the different parts of the body (doctors), healthy foods and staying healthy (chefs).

Other areas of learning

We will be exploring colour and shape through creative activities including colour mixing to make fire pictures and will be designing and building animal carriers for our vet's surgery role play area.

We will also be continuing with Religious Education lessons; this term looking at Bible stories from the Old Testament.

Children will take part in physical activities through weekly PE lessons and daily gross motor skill development activities during children's independent learning time.
