

SATS Results 2015

We are very pleased to produce our end of Year 6 SATs results for 2015. Please note that a Level 4 is deemed as average for the end of Key Stage Two and a Level 5+ is deemed above average attainment. The Summary Table below gives a full breakdown of the results but the headline figures are as follows:

Reading

Level 4+ 95% - above national average of 89%

Level 5+ 65% - significantly above national average of 48%

Spelling Grammar and Punctuation

Level4+ 86% - above national average of 80%

Level5+ 68% - well above national average of 55%

Writing - Teacher assessment

Level4+ 83% - just below national average of 87%

Level5+ 48% - significantly above national average of 36%

Maths

Level4+ 93% - above national average of 87%

Level 5+ 56% - significantly above national average of 41%

We are justifiably proud of all our Year 6 pupils as these results are a significant improvement on the 2014 results and are more comparable with our schools academic performance in previous years.
