Dear Parents

During the Spring Term, Year 3 & 4 will be going swimming in the pool at Branston Community College. The 6 sessions will be for an hour every Friday mornings 10.30am - 11.30am. The first session will be on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> February and the last Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2016.

Branston Community Colleges' Health & Safety Policy states that all swimmers, boys and girls, must wear a swimming hat to comply with new regulations. This policy will ensure the efficient running of the pool's filtration system and ensure all students swim in the safest of environments. Swimming is part of the National Curriculum. If children are unable to go swimming because they have forgotten their swimming kit, hat or towel, then refunds will not be made.

Please can you ensure that your child has a swimming hat, which can be purchased at school for the price of £2.00 or at sports shops and leisure centres by 5<sup>th</sup> February.

The children will be travelling to Branston by coach and in order to cover the cost of this transport, we need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £21.00 per child. It is possible to pay in instalments. Please complete the slip giving permission for your child to go on the coach to the swimming pool and return before the swimming date. The voluntary contribution can be sent in at a later date.

**These visits form an integral part of the curriculum and, as such, are extremely worthwhile. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 (as consolidated in the Education Act 1996) we can only raise the cost of the (visit, activity, etc.) by voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made. However, it must be stressed that school funds are not sufficient to organise such visits without voluntary help.**
