Animals and Humans

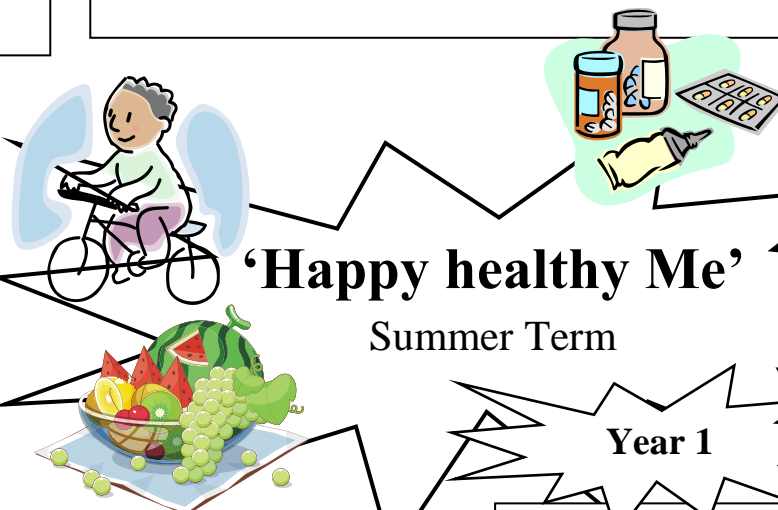
- learning about how people and other animals grow and move
