Achieving these goals will require:

The family to work in partnership with the school by:

- Helping your child understand the home school agreement.
- Making sure your child arrives at school on time in school uniform, having had a healthy breakfast and ready to learn.
- Making sure child attends school regularly and provide an explanation before 10am on the first day of absence.
- Sharing books, and listening to your child read, on a regular basis whatever their age. Reading is essential to your child's learning and forms part of their homework.
- Supporting your child with other homework tasks and ensuring homework is returned within the set time.
- Letting the school know about any problems that might affect your child's work or behaviour
- Attending parents' consultations and other events in school
- Supporting the school and PFA (Parents and Friends Association) in fundraising and other activities
- Foster a positive attitude towards education and the school. Please use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of your child, as these may have a negative effect on their outlook.

The School to work in partnership with you as parents/ carers by:

- Ensuring that your child is safe and happy in school and enjoying their education.
- Endeavouring to meet the needs of your child to achieve their full potential.
- Ensuring that each classroom is a positive and stimulating environment.
- Formally informing you of your child's progress and maintain regular contact as necessary.
- Providing prompt information about behaviour or class work that may be a cause for concern or celebration.
- Informing you about what your child will be taught each half term.
- Supporting you with home learning by setting and monitoring appropriate homework
- Teaching your child to develop positive attitudes towards everyone regardless of difference in gender, race, culture, belief, values, age, disabilities and need
- Communicating effectively and sensitively

The child will contribute by keeping the West Vale School Rules;

- Be kind and polite, friendly and respectful to everyone in School.
- Take care of our School and playground.
- Work quietly and let other people get on with their work.
- Listen carefully to other people.
- Take care of our belongings.
- Act sensibly and safely at all times.
