




Whitelow 1 have been enjoying listening and role playing the story "Whatever Next". We have made a shopping list for our moon picnic with Baby Bear next week.

Redvales 1 have been very busy this week we have continued on the "Aliens and Planets" theme. We have created our own spaceships and had a lovely story about the Aliens' Planet. We have also looked at the artwork of Vladimir Kush and then made our own interpretation of his work



Whitelow 2 There has been a lot of exciting weather this week and the children in Whitelow 2 have been making the most of it; listening to the rain pattering on the roof of the playhouse, drawing weather pictures and learning to read weather words. They also had a fabulous time doing Scientific play with the wind, getting it to make their carrier bag kites fly.

Redvales 2 have been working on 3D shapes this week. We have been building models and looking at their shapes. In Design and Technology we have been looking at different buildings then building towers out of Lego and testing their strength.



Redvales 3 We have had a fantastic week! We have worked really hard learning all about 't' in phonics. We have also been making Chinese dragon masks ready for Chinese New Year. We painted with our hands to create fiery prints using red, orange and yellow paint. We have also been learning about shapes in maths and had great fun printing and making pictures using shapes.



Redvales 5 have had a fantastic week! We have been working hard in Maths sharing and grouping. Some of the pupils excelled by sharing 10 bears between 2 groups independently!



Redvales 6 We have had another fantastic week! In R.E. we learnt about the story of Noah's Ark and enjoyed water play and creating beautiful rainbow pictures. We also loved retelling the story of "Goldilocks and the Three Bears" in Music using instruments.



Irwell 1 have had a fantastic week exploring our new book "Dear Zoo". We have been learning to recognise all the different animal names, their signs and have also been comparing the patterns of their fur coats.



Irwell 2 This week Irwell 2 have been working hard in literacy looking at two books: "Zog" and "The Stick Man". Here is the pupils' very own Stick Man waving to us.



We have also been working on our money skills again buying things from the class shop.



Irwell 3 went swimming again on Monday. We are really improving in our water skills and having lots of fun at the same time. In numeracy we have been learning about capacity and were very good at recognising whether the cups were full, empty or half full. In art we created 3 dimensional Giants' faces using dried food and in food tech we practised our life skills by making a Giant's face from vegetables and wraps.




Irwell 4
