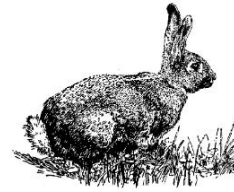

We are writing to you for your support in connection with the continued safety and security of our children and staff.

Although fulfilling a public function our schools are private places to which the public has no automatic right of entry. As such, schools have the right to act to ensure they remain a safe and secure place for their pupils, their staff and other members of their community.

If any parent/guardians behaviour is a cause for concern the school can ask the parent/guardians concerned to leave the school premises with immediate effect. In serious cases, our head teachers or the local authority can notify the parent/guardians concerned in writing that their implied licence to be on school premises has been temporarily revoked subject to any representations that they may wish to make.
