My eldest son is now an Apprentice Teaching Assistant at St Anne's and my youngest is a pupil here.</p> <p>I am the current Chairperson of the Friends of St Anne's Committee, and am very proud of what we have achieved in the past couple of years – particularly our Parent Support Group.</p> <p>I also volunteer for the East Riding Portage Service.
