

Phase 4 Sentences for Reading

- ★ These sentences build on the skills children have been building in Phases 2 & 3.
- ★ Point out the capital letter and full stop in each sentence. It is important to get children to recognise these features of text early on.
- ★ Cut up the sentences and practise reading them. If your child struggles with any words, think about which grapheme they struggle with e.g. is it 'ow' (as in down)? If so, go back and practise 'ow' words.
