

## Phase 5 Sentence Substitution - Guide (the example below is taken from Phase 3)

Cut the top sentence into a single strip.

The sheep are in the shed.

bedroom      farmyard      cars      wait

Cut the 4 words into separate pieces.

The sheep are in the bedroom

The cars are in the shed.

The sheep are in the farmyard

See how many different sentences you can make by 'substituting' words in the original sentence with those on the individual cards.

☺ Encourage your child to read each sentence and check that it makes sense.

☺ You can 'substitute' more than one word in each sentence.

☺ There are 10 different sentences to 'play with' in Phase 5. Try not to mix up the word cards as they have been written for the sentence they are attached to.
