Dear Parents

As part of our topic work this term, Class 1, 2 and 3 will be going on a trip to Lincoln Castle on Wednesday 2nd March 2016.

The children will explore the Castle grounds and buildings and have the opportunity to discover different features around the area and think about how life may have been. The trip links directly to our topics, 'Towers, Tunnels and Turrets' and '1066'. We also have specialized workshops booked for the day to make the most of our visit.

Children will need to be dressed in *school uniform* but should be prepared for all weather conditions. A waterproof coat is advisable in case of rain. The children will also need a packed lunch with an extra drink. However, a lunch will be provided for those who normally have a free school dinner.

If your child suffers with travel sickness please make the class teacher aware of this. It would be advisable to administer the travel sickness tablet before they come to school and enclose another tablet if required for the journey back.

The cost for the trip will be £11.90. These visits form an integral part of the curriculum and as such, are extremely worthwhile. Unfortunately, such activities cannot be funded without voluntary contributions from parents. Parents are under no obligation and no child will be omitted because parents are either unwilling or unable to contribute. However, it must be stressed that school funds are not sufficient to organise such visits without voluntary help and therefore may be cancelled.
