<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All pupils eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) in FS2 (Reception) achieved a 'Good Level of Development' at the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). This is better than the National. Outcomes for FSM pupils in Y1 were in line with National for the Phonic Screening test. All FSM pupils in Y2 performed better than other FSM pupils nationally in Reading, Writing and Maths (RWM) based on 'average points scores' The % of FSM pupils achieving the expected standard (L4+ in RWM) at the end of KS2 was in line with other FSM pupils nationally All FSM pupils in Y6 achieved L4 or above in Maths The % of FSM pupils achieving L5 in Reading was higher than the National All children made at least expected (2 levels) progress from KS1 to KS2 in Reading
