



Religious Education

Religious Education follows the Coventry Agreed Syllabus. At Walsgrave some aspects of Religious Education are taught through themes e.g. weddings, christenings etc.

In Key Stage One the customs and beliefs of two or more religions are compared. In Key Stage Two Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism are studied in a systematic way so that the children are able to understand the essential elements of these religions.

Visits to places of worship and speakers in school are a routine feature of our Religious Education lessons.

All teaching is constrained within the Governor's formal statement, as follows:

"We do not seek to convert, persuade or indoctrinate. Rather, by informing children about the major world religions we seek to bring understanding, foster tolerance and empathy and develop a feeling of respect and acceptance for all people's beliefs."
