

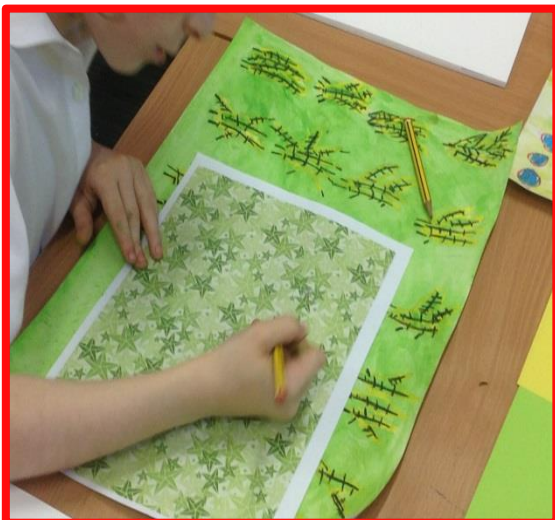


## Art at Clifford Bridge Academy
