Year 1

Reading	Words & Spelling
<p>It is expected that all children are to read regularly at home with an adult. Reading should be recorded clearly in the reading diary. Children need to ensure that they bring their Reading Diary and Book with them into school every day.</p>	<p>Children will be given sets of High Frequency words to be practise reading at home. By the end of the year children should also be confident in spelling these words in their school work and any in their POWER Projects. (Please see KS1 curriculum Spelling List Below)</p>

<p>Power Projects are to be completed each term in line with the Current topic and written work should be recorded in the Learning Log Book.</p>	<p>Children are set weekly homework via the Mathletics Website. Log ins and passwords can be found the children's reading diaries. </p>

Year 2

Reading	Spelling
<p>It is expected that all children are to read regularly at home with an adult. Reading should be recorded clearly in the reading diary. Children need to ensure that they bring their Reading Diary and Book with them into school every day.</p>	<p>By the first term in Year 2 many children will have finished their sets of High Frequency words. Children will now be focussing on practising a list of spellings each week and will be given a weekly spelling test in class.</p>

<p>Power Projects are to be completed each term in line with the Current topic and written work should be recorded in the Learning Log Book.</p>	<p>Children are set weekly homework via the Mathletics Website. Log ins and passwords can be found the children's reading diaries. </p>

<p>From Spring Term onwards children will receive SATs revision packs: These will included a range of resources to help children prepare and consolidate the learning they have done in school. These can be comprehensions, handwriting, grammar exercises, writing or maths activities.</p>
