



Reading in Key Stage 1

As you already know, reading is extremely important to aid your child's progress with all their learning. Please try to listen to them read as often as possible - *at least* three times a week. Whenever you read with your child please write in their diary telling us which **page number** they have reached. If you feel that your child is reading with confidence and understanding, and think that they are ready to move onto a new book, please write clearly "***Please change book***".

Reading Rewards!

Children also have a chance to earn 'Reading Rewards' for consistent reading at home and in school. In the back of your child's reading diary there is a reading reward grid. Your child will receive a stamp every time their book is changed for a new one.

- When children have **6 stamps in a row**, they will be able to choose a sweetie.
- When children have all **24 stamps on the grid**, they will be able to choose a special toy from the box!

Finished reading books will be changed on **Mondays, Wednesdays** and **Fridays**.

Your child will also be heard read by their Class Teachers and Teaching Assistants during school time. Please do not hesitate to ask if you have any questions.
