

Over the past academic year £3883 was spent on CPD for staff, £230 was spent on mini bus hire to improve attendance in level 2 competitions, £127 spent on HSSA affiliation fee which has enabled us to take part in athletics competition and the dance festival.

To develop confidence in the delivery of gymnastics	There has been some disruption during the autumn term to the CPD however the CPD sessions were all made protected during Christmas discussions with SLT. The spring and summer terms CPD ran smoothly and end of unit observations showed significant improvement in the delivery of gymnastics. Teachers report feeling more confident. The children have reported enjoying the sessions and they are keen to take part. Some staffing issues led to a disjointed CPD term for R and Y1/2. The percentage active is still a concern.	Discussions with CPD providers to ensure we are employing the highest quality. Bee Active discussions – assurance that the two CPD providers will be consistent throughout the year. They have also been told to focus on the % of time the children are active as well as showing staff how to plan, structure and implement invasion games. Each staff member is doing a different invasion game to build up the skills set. New planning proforma book to keep a track of the CPD in more details.
To develop teachers subject pedagogy and ensure terminology is being used accurately across the school.	The CPD has proved exceedingly effective. Staff and children are now using technical vocabulary accurately which is evidence of an improvement in pedagogy.
