



Attendance Policy for children

Why is it important to come to school every day and on time?

- So that you don't miss any learning
- So that you make the best progress you can
- So that you can see our friends, enjoy yourself and have fun
- So that you can go on trips and see visitors in school
- So that you can take part in clubs and teams
- It is the law

If you don't come to school your parents or carers may get into trouble

What will happen if I don't come to school every day?

- You miss out on learning and might not make the progress you are capable of
- You miss out on being with your friends and having fun
- You might miss out on trips, visitors, activities and clubs
- Your parents or carers might get into trouble

What is good attendance?

96% and above

- You will get a certificate if your attendance is above 96% for the year
- Each half term you have 100% attendance and are not late any day, you will be entered for the attendance prize draw. If you win you will get a voucher for £10
- If you have 100% attendance for a year you will have a treat and your name will be entered into the attendance draw to win a voucher for £50
- If you have only had time off for Eid we will count your attendance as 100%

What should I do if I am really ill and can't come to school?

If you are really ill your mum, dad or carer should telephone the school on 235711 to tell us why you will not be at school. If they don't telephone school, somebody from school will call your mum, dad or carer to ask why you are not in school

Let's work together to have the best attendance possible, and don't forget that you need to be on time too!
