As you will be aware, KS2 SATs week is fast approaching and will commence on Monday 9th April. The timetable is as follows:

Monday 9 th May - am	English Reading Test
Tuesday 10 th May - am	Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Tests
Wednesday 11 th May - am	Maths Arithmetic Test Maths Reasoning Test 1
Thursday 12 th May - am	Maths Reasoning Test 2
