Class targets for 2015 - 2016

Y1 and Year 2 have raised £171.89 which was doubled by the school so they have a grand total of £343.78. Their target was to improve the equipment in the kitchen area.

Next steps – Year 1 and 2 classes/teachers need to order required equipment for the kitchen. If any money is left over then they would like a new character bin on their playground.

The Y3 and 4 wanted to improve the climbing wall so they have worked together and raised approx. £140 which was doubled by the school so they have a grand total of £280 to spend.

Next steps – Year 3/4 to work with Jackie to organise a builder to improve the climbing wall and get the work done as soon as possible.

Y5 wanted to improve the quiet area and create a reading corner / shed near the environmental area. Y5 have decided to do a popcorn sale and have formed 5 working groups – costings, making, selling, publicity and finance. Part of the group presented their plan, via a PowerPoint presentation and took feedback on their ideas including the flavours they would be selling. The school council agreed that the best date for the sale was the week after SATS but week before Pensarn.

Next steps – Year 5/Miss Rose to plan for this week

Y6 - Class helpers – a survey was completed and some changes to the rota and timings were made. All seems to be working fine now.

Other Matters

Litter

- Year 3 had previously raised litter as an issue and suggested that each class had a turn collecting litter at morning break using long arm litter pickers from Jackie.

- School Council discussed and agreed the following rota for litter picking at morning break – 2 children from each class
