Policy for School uniform from September 2014

We encourage our children to be part of the school family and attend school ready to work. Part of this ethos includes our uniform. It gives the children a sense of belonging while offering a sensible set of clothing that is suitable for the school day.

Uniform comprises:-

Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan,
White polo shirt,
Grey or black skirt / trousers,
Dark, sensible footwear

In summer -long-sleeved, light cotton white tops/shirts or blue gingham dresses and light cardigans are encouraged to keep cool but also covered from the sun.

Sweatshirts, Fleece and Waterproofs are available to order from the school office at cost but uniform without the logo is just as acceptable.

Please remember

High heeled shoes, open toed sandals and bare feet / midriffs are not allowed in school.

Hair styles should be appropriate for a primary school. Stepped hair, tram lines or patterns cut in the hair are not allowed. Long hair should be suitably fastened back

Jewellery must not be worn apart from watches.

Children with pierced ears must wear plain studs. They must also be able to remove their own studs for PE and cannot take part if they cannot remove them. To avoid having to miss PE lessons we recommend that children should only have their ears pierced at the start of the summer holidays.

PE kit

From Y1 all pupils should be provided with the following in a suitable drawstring bag

White T shirt

Black or blue shorts

A pair of pumps (necessary for some activities but most indoor PE work is done barefoot).

Swimwear is required for Y3 to Y6 pupils.

Girls- Swimming costumes (not bikinis)

Boys – Swimming trunks/shorts (long/loose Bermuda style shorts are not allowed)
