



# Coppice Farm Primary Curriculum 2016 for Year1

## Year 1 Reading expectations

### How can I help?

#### Word Reading and understanding what they have read

- Use phonics to help read unknown words
- Identify with your child word endings such as ing, es, ed
- Show your child where apostrophes are used in words for contractions or missed out letters.
- Re- read books to build up fluency and confidence.
- Re- read text when they sense they have made a mistake
- Discuss the main events of the story or text
- Identify hidden meaning and clues to what might happen.
- Encourage your child to predict what might happen next
- Participate in discussion about what is read to them, taking turns and listening to what you have to say.
- Encourage children to explain clearly their understanding of what is read to them.

Discuss meanings of any unknown words in the book.

Discuss with your child the title of the book and the main events of the story.

## Year 1 Writing expectations

### How can I help?

#### Handwriting

- Encourage your child to sit correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and correctly. Both feet flat on the floor.
- Show your child how to form lower case letters from the correct starting point.
- Form capital letters. Help your child identify all capital letters.
- Form digits 0-9.

#### Composition

- Write sentences by:
- Saying out loud what they are going to write about;
- Write a number of sentences about something they have done in the correct order.
- Re-read what they have written and correct any errors
- Discuss what they have written with you
- Read aloud their writing to an adult.

## Year 1 Maths expectations

### How can I help?

#### Place Value

- Count out aloud with you forwards and backwards to 100
- Count in twos, fives and tens.
- Say a number one more or one less than a number you give them
- Describe groups of objects you give them with the most or the fewest
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.

#### Addition & Subtraction

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
- Ask your child to make ten in different ways with addition sums.
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.
- Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as  $7 = \square - 9$ .

#### Multiplication & Division

- Ask your child simple shopping problems which involve buying 2 of something.

#### Fractions

- Ask your child to find half of a number of group of objects.
- Recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. Make a group of objects into 4 equal amounts.

#### Measurement

- Describe objects according to size and weight such as heavier lighter or tallest and shortest.
- Describe time [for example, quicker, slower, earlier, later.
- Measure objects with a ruler
- Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. Ask your child to count with money.
- Ask your child to tell you what day it is today, yesterday and tomorrow.

Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

#### Geometry: Properties of Shape

- Identify 2D such they can see in everyday objects such as square windows in your house
- 3-D shapes. Can your child name the shape of a cereal box and other items in the house.

#### Geometry: Position & Direction

- Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.
