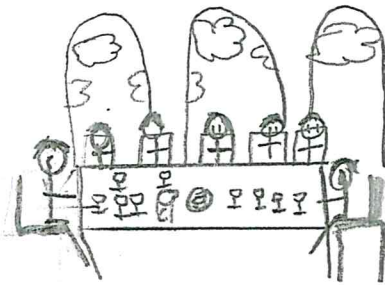


Maundy Surprise
