

# How we promote British Values at Broughton Moor Primary School.

## Rule of Law [1]

- We will talk about expectations/ attendance and behaviours during assemblies
- We learn about rules and behaviours to keep us safe
- We will write and share classroom rules and rules around school

## Democracy [2]

- We will hold debates and open ended discussions
- We have roles and responsibilities in school. Play leaders/ helpers/ classroom monitors
- We will fund raise for charities throughout the year.

## Democracy [1]

- We will elect and put in place a school council
- We will learn about the Monarchy and the Monarchy in previous years (Yr2)
- We will learn about apartheid/ Black history yr5/6
- We learn about the Monarchy political leaders from the past from Britain (KS2)

## Faiths and Beliefs [2]

- We will provide themed cooking experiences linked to different cultures/ festivals
- We will provide opportunities to visit places of worship
- We will have visits from Religious Leaders.
- We have strong link with the local church

## Rule of Law [2]

- We will learn about E Safety
- We will have road safety training
- We will explore the roles of people who can help us



## Individual Learning [1]

- We will provide opportunities for child led learning, through homework projects, pupil choice lessons, child initiated learning (EYFS), continuous areas of provision (yr1)
- We provide children with choices For example lunch menu choices, reading book choices
- We provide children with after school club choices.

## Individual Learning [2]

- We will provide children with life skills as part of golden time lessons such as life skills, gardening, career readiness, outdoor building and mending skills.
- We will take part in concerts, choir and performances throughout the year auditioning for roles.

## Faiths and Beliefs [1]

- We will ask children to complete pupil questionnaires
- We will celebrate different Festivals throughout the academic year.
- We will share stories with children exploring morals/ cultures/ beliefs.
