Dear Parents/Guardians

Please be aware of the following information about our visit to Yorkshire Wildlife Park on Monday 16th May.

As the children will spend most of the day outdoors, they will need to be prepared for the weather. It would be advisable for them to have a waterproof coat in case of rain and sun hats, sun cream and extra drinks may be needed if we have hot weather. The children have been asked to wear their school jumpers, but can wear comfortable shoes and trousers/jeans.

All children will need to take a packed lunch and a drink. As there is nowhere to store lunches and coats, they will need to have a suitable bag to carry their belongings around with them. The children may take a small amount of spending money in case there is an opportunity to visit the gift shop - they will be responsible for this during the day.

If your child suffers with travel sickness, please make me aware of this. It would be advisable to administer travel sickness tablets before they come to school and enclose another tablet for the return journey in a named envelope.

The children have all worked very hard over the past few weeks, especially those in Year 6 who have taken SATs tests this week. They have shown great resilience and determination and we are all now looking forward to a relaxing day on Monday.
