Bamburgh Visit 2016

With the residential week almost upon us, please find below the final arrangements to ensure the week runs smoothly.

DEPARTURE 8.00 am - Monday 6 June

Please ensure that your child is in the KS2 school hall no later than **7.40am** on Monday 6 June morning in readiness for the journey to Bamburgh. They will require a packed lunch and drink contained in a day bag suitable for carrying around Beamish Museum and a pencil. Whilst we hope for a sunny day on Monday we cannot guarantee it and so please ensure that children also have a waterproof coat and sensible shoes.

Children will also need a named refillable water bottle for use throughout the week.



Please also ensure your child brings a hat (preferably baseball style cap) to wear on the visit to the Farne Islands as we have been informed by our supplier that there is a distinct possibility that the caps ordered by school will not be ready for delivery until after the visit.



On Monday 6 June suitcases should be labelled and left on Church Road ready for loading onto the coach. Day bags are to be kept by the children who should assemble in the KS2 Main Hall.

As in previous years, children will not be permitted to bring hand held electrical items such as 'Gameboys', 'iPods' and definitely **NO** mobile phones. They may take books, magazines or small travel board games for use during the journey. Cameras (and batteries as required) are allowed, including disposable cameras, as photographs can often be an excellent record of their experiences and can be used to illustrate their 'Bamburgh Books'.

PTO

Any medicines that your child needs to take on the visit **MUST** be named, labelled and handed to their group leader on arrival at school on **Monday 6 June**.

If children wish to take spending money, please ensure that they have no more than £3.00 per day. School will issue each child with 5 money bags. Please place a maximum of £3.00 coins in each bag and send them back with your child on **Monday 6 June** and hand to their group leader. This money is, however, **only** necessary if children wish to purchase souvenirs or mementos of the visit.

The children will return to North Ferriby at approximately 5.00 pm on Friday 10 June.
