Our school has chosen to effectively use this premium for 2015-2016 in the following ways:

Hinckley and Bosworth PE Partnership Package and collaboration	£780	This package includes 2 hour school support visit and PE improvement planning for the School to ensure effective monitoring is taking place. A 3 hour course place, subject leader network meetings (2x a year), place on the PE conference, afPE Safe Practice in PE guide and survey support, discounts on Val Sabin publications.
ICT Software package licence	£150	PE coordinator to monitor attitudes and responses to PE from children, particularly vulnerable groups participation in extra curricular activities.
Monitoring and Evaluating Inspections from an external inspector	£600	An external Ofsted inspector to observe PE lessons across school led by other PE staff and offer advice and support for the PE Coordinator regarding Ofsted inspection process about PE.

This is to sustain the good work of PE in the future when our current PE leader retires.</p>

<p>Artsmark Creditation- Dance Opportunities</p>	<p>£200 per year group £ 1400</p>	<p>Children will participate in Dance Workshops across all year groups to gain an appreciation of dance and understand the different art forms and audience awareness. Dance skills across a range of genres will be observed and carried out in lessons.</p> <p>A whole school performance linked to the value 'Trust' will take place in the Summer term for parents/carers. This will help us gain the certificate for the Silver Artsmark award.</p>

New PE equipment (Ongoing resources)	£1000	Replenish PE stock and resources. JC to carry out PE equipment audit prior to purchasing new stock.
Val Sabin training for teachers who now deliver PE Therapeutic Play course	£745	Teachers who now deliver PE will know how to teach and assess PE in line with the Val Sabin PE scheme. (4x teachers to attend the training) SEN support assistant to attend the therapeutic play training to offer support across school to children who find playing games outside difficult because of SEND needs. To lead and facilitate this kind of play during playtimes.
Games equipment in line with the Val Sabin scheme	£300	To purchase a colour co-ordinated set of equipment for lessons with whole classes and groups for KS1 and FS.
Swimming Assessment pack	£80	Assessment pack to be used by school's own swimming instructor to regularly assess children's swimming skills and requirements. Accurate assessments will lead to a more in depth profile of each child's swimming ability.
Swimming lessons for children who need extra support	£265	The school will offer swimming lessons to those children in Years 4,5 and 6 who still cannot swim confidently to ensure they are able to swim 25m independently following 2 terms of swimming teaching already.
